Classroom Partnership Program

Collaborate with UCSF scientists to co-plan and co-teach 3 engaging, hands-on lessons

- Get support teaching science from a UCSF scientist
- Open to K-12 teachers
- Program commitment is typically ~20 hours



STEM Storytime

One-time visit for K-5 classes from a UCSF scientist. Scientists read a STEM picture book to a classroom, then lead a short related activity or host a brief Q&A about being a scientist/health professional
